Co-author of *Effective Interviewing & Interrogation Techniques*, now in its second edition, Gordon also is a full member and director of the Vidocq Society.



William L. Fleisher: William L. Fleisher, a full member of the American Polygraph Association and nationally known for polygraph expertise. He spent more than 35 years with federal and local law enforcement before his retirement, as an Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the U.S. Customs Service (now I.C.E. in the Department of Homeland Security). Prior to the Customs Service Fleisher was a Special Agent of the FBI and, before that, he was a Philadelphia Police Department corporal. A Certified Fraud Examiner and full member of the American Polygraph Association and the Pennsylvania Polygraph Examiners Association, Fleisher has lectured on Behavioral Analysis to law enforcement and intelligence agencies in the U.S. and overseas. He also is a member of ASIS International, Intelnet, the American College of Forensic Examiners and the Society of Former Special Agents of the FBI. A co-author of *Effective Interviewing & Interrogation Techniques*, now in its second edition, Fleisher is also a co-founder and Commissioner of the Vidocq Society.
